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### **PROPERTY MANAGER'S CORNER**

There are several projects and service schedule changes homeowners need to be

aware of for this fall/winter. There is a service/events calendar on the Wood Creek page of Crofton's website where these services and events are also posted. Feel free to reference the calendar at any time, 24/7.

- 1. Exterior Painting
  - a. This project is now complete. Next year the HOA will be painting 34 units in total. Notice will be given late summer for the start date.
- 2. Fall Gutter Cleaning
  - a. Every fall the Association has the gutters cleaned. The gutters will not stay clean however. Throughout the rest of the year homeowner can request additional gutter cleaning. Fall gutter cleaning typically occurs after the majority of leaves have fallen, close to Thanksgiving.
- 3. Shrub Pruning
  - a. Gary Romig and his crew have completed the fall shrub pruning. The pruning was an ongoing project which was completed on a weekly basis.
- 4. <u>Shrub Replacements</u>
  - a. There were very few shrub replacement requests this year. Shrubs will be inspected again next spring for any replacement needs.
- 5. Fall Cleanup
  - a. Fall cleanup is underway now that mowing has been completed for the season. Romig's crew can be expected on any day of the week. Cleanups will continue until the winter weather takes hold or the trees are bare, whichever comes first.

- 6. <u>Refuse Delays</u>
  - a. Garbage collection will be delayed from Thursday to Friday in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday. Christmas and New Year's occur on Sundays this year and will not affect collection.
- 7. <u>Crofton Office Closings</u> calls will continue to be taken by the answering service at (585) 248-3840 and a property manager will be on-call.
  - a. Our office will be closed on:
    - i. Thursday & Friday, November 24 & 25, 2016 (Thanksgiving)
    - ii. Monday, December 26, 2016 (Christmas)
    - iii. Monday, January 2, 2017 (New Year's)
- 8. Plowing Contractor
  - a. Snow removal will be offered by Magic Plow again this year. The plowing season technically begins on November 1<sup>st</sup>. Thank goodness we haven't seen any white stuff yet. Once we do, snow will be plowed/shoveled after 3" of accumulation over 50% of all asphalt surfaces. The Association plows do not come though as frequently as the Town of Pittsford plows; they have different specification they follow. The steps for the 5 addresses on upper Creek Ridge will be shoveled, along with all courtyard sidewalks and the space in front of the garage doors. Please bear in mind the plows have a routine to follow. They will plow the main roads first, then come back for the driveways and the shoveling will be done by a separate crew.
  - b. If you have questions about winter services, please contact Crofton instead of stopping the contractor. It is not safe to approach the driver of the plow on foot, especially if visibility is poor. This way the contractor can stay on schedule and Crofton can stay abreast of any concerns with the service.

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#### **GENERAL REMINDERS**



Snow plowing and shoveling is done when there are at least three inches of snow. Also, please remember to keep driveways clear of cars. The plow can't plow any driveway that has a car in it. Please see Crofton article above, #8a.

Bird feeders may be used only between October 1st and April 3rd. During the rest of the year, either the bird feeders or the food must be removed.

Winter is the time many of our residents travel to warmer climates, and it is always a good idea to prepare for your home while away. The following is from the *Wood Creek Homeowners Handbook*.

Before leaving for an extended period of time (more than one month):

- Every homeowner should have emergency contact information on file with Crofton Associates.
- Give someone you know a key and your contact information and ask them to check your home at least once a week.
- Tell the Property Management Office who has your key, when they will be checking your home, and what their phone number is.
- Secure your home to guard against water line breakage and burglary. Turn off water and drain interior plumbing system. Replace washer hoses older than 7 years.
- Keep an adequate amount of heat in the home. Setting the thermostat no lower than 55°F is recommended.
- Discontinue newspaper and mail delivery.

It was suggested by a resident that it's a good idea to place a brick on your recyclables to hold them in place on a windy day.

Sidewalks are going to be repaired starting this fiscal year, beginning with those most in need. These repairs will take place over a five-year period.

Power washing is permitted on decks and cement steps and sidewalks to brighten them up, using water only.

Trees are being replaced starting this fall for most varieties except for Japanese lilacs.

Keep abreast of what is happening in your community by reading the periodic newsletter, checking the website regularly (<u>www.woodcreekhoa.org</u>), attending monthly Board meetings and special sessions like informal community meetings.
